<b>Property Identification</b>	<b>Goose Rocks Light, Knox County, North Haven, Maine</b>
<b>Property Address</b>	<b>Located near the East entrance of Fox Islands Thorofare; Found about 400 yards from westerly end of Stimpson's Island, E. Penobscot Bay</b>
<b>Property Description</b>	<b>One of four "spark plug" lights in Maine; (1890) on ledge - .10 acre. Ledge is wholly submerged at high tide, with an exposed area approx. 2,000 SF at low tide. 51 ft. tower; four stories; cast iron, cylindrical steel construction; concrete caisson foundation. Keeper's quarters and storage facility within its walls. Painted black &amp; white.</b>
<b>Condition</b>	<b>The property is offered "AS IS" and "WHERE IS" without representation, warranty, or guarantee as to quality, quantity, title, character, condition, size or kind. Fourth order Fresnel lens has been removed.</b>
<b>Historical Information</b>	<b>Listed on the National Register of Historic Places (#87002267). Property must be maintained in accordance with the Secretary of Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation. Historic covenants will be incorporated into the Deed.</b>
<b>Current Tenant</b>	<b>None at this time.</b>
<b>Range of Possible Uses</b>	<b>NHLPA allows use for educational, park, recreational, cultural or historic preservation purposes.</b>
<b>Commercial Activities</b>	<b>Commercial activities are prohibited unless approved by the Secretary of the Interior.</b>
<b>Utilities</b>	<b>None (solar power for navigational aid)</b>
<b>Aid to Navigation (ATON)/Fog Signal Horn</b>	<b>Active aid to navigation with fog signal horn (one blast every 10 seconds). Flashing red every six seconds. ATON remains the personal property of the U.S. Coast Guard.</b>
<b>Easements – to be retained by the U.S. Coast Guard</b>	<b>1) a 360 degree arc of visibility easement; and 2) an easement for an unrestricted right of access in, to and across the Property to maintain, operate, service, repair and install equipment as necessary to support its ATON mission and; 3) the unrestricted right to relocate or add any aids to navigation or communications towers and equipment (along with necessary right of egress/ingress), or make any changes on any portion of the Property as may be necessary for navigation/public safety purposes.</b>
<b>Environmental Information</b>	<b>Due to age of structure, possible asbestos containing building materials. Lead based paint.</b>
<b>Notice Response Due Date</b>	<b>60 days from date of this Notice</b>
<b>Access/Inspection</b>	<b>Not open to the public. Best seen by boat; there are public cruises out of Camden, Maine. Open House for eligible applicants will be arranged by the U.S. General Services Administration, Boston.</b>
